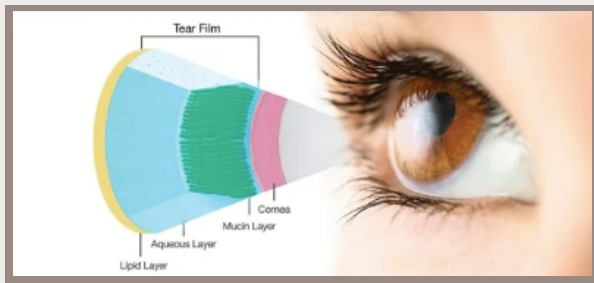


What is Dry Eye Syndrome?

Dry Eye Syndrome is a multifactorial disease of the tears and ocular surface that causes discomfort, visual disturbance, and tear film instability and has the potential to damage the ocular surface.



Dry Eye Syndrome occurs when the quality or quantity of tears is compromised. Tears, which maintain vision and eye health, consists of three layers: mucous, water, and oil. When we blink, the eyelids spread a tear film over the surface of the eye. Healthy tears are a balance of water and oil to keep the surface of the eye moist, wash away dust and debris, and help to protect the eye from infection.

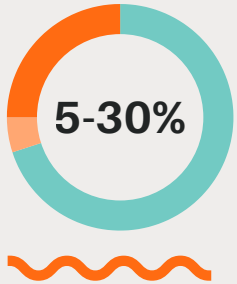

Dry Eye Syndrome is caused by a variety of factors including:
